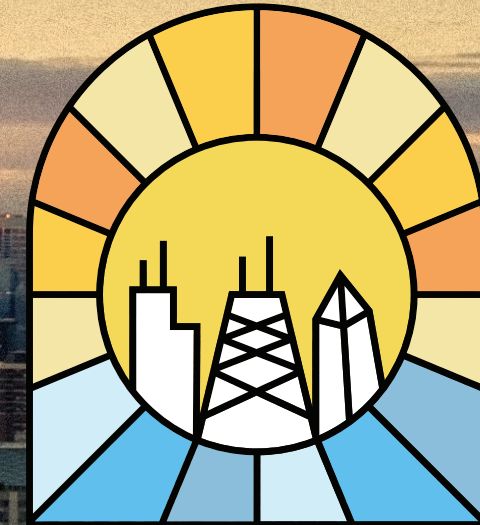

## GENEROSITY

## MINISTRIES

*In the next ten years, we hope to:*



Double the impact of our Sunday worship services, expand our third space outreach events, and make City Groups more hospitable to the unchurched.



Build a robust pipeline of discipleship for ages 11-30, including a vibrant youth group, a campus ministry partnership, and a young adult residency program that equips them for missional living.



Establish a central mercy ministry in our community that cares for vulnerable children and families.



Strengthen the support systems for our families and single adults for long-term urban flourishing.



Become a church for the nations: doubling the number of missionaries we are sending abroad.
